Undergraduate Admissions-Spring 2025

UET is offering admissions under partially subsidized category (A-2 category) in the following four-year undergraduate programs for **Spring 2025** session in Lahore Campus (LHR), New Campus (KSK), Faisalabad Campus (FSD), Narowal Campus (NWL) and Rachna College (RCET, Gujranwala). The programs in Lahore Campus will be offered in afternoon while programs in other Campuses will be offered in morning.

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1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Intermediate (or equivalent) with relevant combinations and a minimum 50% score is required.
- It is mandatory to appear in the entrance test to be held in UET Lahore Main Campus on **Saturday, December 21, 2024 and Sunday, December 22, 2024** (Previous ECAT will not be accepted) for ECAT based programs as mentioned in Table 1.
- ECAT for Fall 2025 semester will be arranged later / separately.
- Physical appearance and minimum 50% marks are mandatory in interview for securing admission. The interview will be organized for shortlisted candidates only.

2. MERIT CALCULATION

For ECAT Based Programs	For Non ECAT Based Programs

The further distribution of 70% weight of Matric and F.Sc. (or equivalent) marks will be considered as: "The Matric and first-year intermediate scores shall be weighted 25% and 45%, respectively. In case the applicant has done O-levels then the entire 70% weight shall be assigned to the corresponding IBCC score. For DAE applicants, 70% weight shall be assigned to the sum of the scores obtained in the first and second year.	F.Sc. marks weightage will be calculated as 75% of first year marks and 25% of matric marks then 90% of the weightage will be considered toward final merit. In case the applicant has done O-levels then the entire 90% weight shall be assigned to the corresponding IBCC score. For DAE applicants, 90% weight shall be assigned to the sum of the scores obtained in the first and second years.

3. APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Visit the admissions portal admission.uet.edu.pk
2. Candidates interested and eligible in **both ECAT based programs and Non ECAT based programs** are required to Generate and Pay the Challan of **Rs. 5,000/-** that includes both Entrance Test and Admission Application processing Fee.
3. Candidates interested and eligible **only in Non ECAT based programs** are required to Generate and Pay the Challan of **Rs. 2,500/- per** that covers the Admission Application processing Fee.
4. After Challan payment, fill the Application form and select your preferences. The preference should be selected carefully; you cannot change the preferences after successful submission of the application, the last date for which is **Monday, December 9, 2024**. After application submission, you will receive a tracking number, you need this tracking number to print the admit card to appear in the Entry Test.
5. Candidates are required to Print the Admit card on **Wednesday, December 11, 2024** that mentions the date, time and venue of the test.
6. Candidates are required to appear in Entrance Exam per the allotted time, date, venue and follow the instructions on the Admit Card. Candidates will not get a chance to reappear in the Entrance Test, if the allocated slot is missed.
7. The Entrance Test result will be announced on **Monday, December 23, 2024 (evening)**. For shortlisted candidates, interview time and date will appear on the result card. Planned interview dates are from **Monday, December 30, 2024 to Friday, January 3, 2025**. However, the exact time and venue will be shown on the result card of the entry test.
8. For candidates opting Non ECAT based programs, the interview slip can be printed on **Monday, December 23, 2024 (evening)**
9. The first merit list will be displayed on **Friday, January 10, 2025** on the admissions portal.
10. The last date for document and fee submission will be **Thursday, January 16, 2025**.
11. Schedule of subsequent merit lists and related important dates can be found on the admission website.

4. STANDARD OF THE TEST AND SUBJECTS TO BE TESTED

- a) The Test would be of Intermediate level. It will be offered in the following combinations: (i) Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, (ii) Mathematics, Physics and Computer Science, (iii) Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science, (iv) Biology, Physics and Chemistry and (v) Mathematics, Statistics and Physics. The duration of the Test will be hundred minutes. Ten questions will be related to English and the rest, i.e., ninety, will equally be divided amongst the other subjects. Each correct answer is worth four points and for every incorrect answer one point will be deducted. **There is no passing threshold for any program.**
- b) The candidates should select a combination from one of the above choices, depending on their subjects in Intermediate (or equivalent).
- c) DAE qualified candidates can only choose from the following two options – Physics, Mathematics, English and Chemistry **or** Physics, Mathematics, English and Computer Science.

7. SUPPORT FOR PRINTING OF APPLICATION and ADMIT CARDS

If required, the candidates may use computer and printer facilities, available in the **National Library of Engineering Sciences UET Lahore**, from **Monday, November 18, 2024, until Monday, December 09, 2024**, between **10:00 am to 3:00 pm** with a break for prayer, during working days.

8. REQUIREMENT OF PHOTO-ID AT THE TEST CENTER DURING ENTRANCE TEST

Failure to present a photo-ID may result in expulsion from the Test Center. Following forms of photo-IDs are valid: (1) Computerized National Identity Card CNIC/NICOP; Or (2) Juvenile Card issued by NADRA; Or (3) Matric/Intermediate certificate carrying photograph; Or (4) Computerized domicile certificate bearing a photograph; Or (5) a Passport; Or (6) Statement of Entry in case of "A" Level students.

9. INFORMATION

- a) A candidate who misses the entrance test in the allotted center during the allotted time slot will not be permitted to retake the exam.
- b) Since the test is fully automated, no re-checking facility will be provided.
- c) Entrance test/Admission token once purchased **can't be refunded / Non transferable** at any stage whether utilized or not.
- d) The hostel facility will be offered for Spring 2025 admissions subject to availability. However, a limited transport facility may be offered to commute the students to and from the university.
